Which Tree Suits Me?

Please take a moment to answer the following questions before selecting a tree. If you need assistance choosing, a botanist from John's Nursery will be speaking on Tuesday, July 17 at 6:30pm under the gazebo at the recreation centre and will be available to answer questions and give recommendations.

1. Is the spot wet most of the time, or fairly dry?
2. Will there be sun most of the day? Part of the day? Mostly shade?
3. How much space in feet or meters is there for a tree (how wide can it spread)?
4. Do I need a tree with a narrow shape?
5. Do I love big trees?
6. Would I prefer a small tree that can grow as a specimen under the big forest trees?
7. How close to the house do I want my tree?
8. Are flowers in spring important to me?
9. Do I enjoy wildlife (birds, bees, chipmunks, squirrels) feeding in my yard?
10. Is a bright fall colour important?
